## Make a Flower Crown


Kids, ask your grown-up to help with this project!

## You will need:

- a large paper shopping bag
- crayons, markers, or colored pencils
- scissors (Please be careful.)
- tape
- watercolor paints or food color
- paintbrush
- coffee filters or tissues



Gather your materials where you have plenty of room to color and paint.



Carefully cut the handles off the paper bag.



Place the bag with its bottom closest to you. Have a grown-up use their hand as a measure to draw two straight lines from the bottom edge all the way to top edge of the bag.



Together with a grown-up, cut along both lines. You will make a long strip from your paper bag. This will be your crown!



Get help from a grown-up to wrap your long crown around your head. When it fits just right, they will mark the spot to tape it together. Trim off the extra piece on the strip.





Use your crayons, markers, or pencils to color your crown. Green is nice!



Tape your crown together.



Using one of your extra pieces of paper, color it green. Make small cuts partway down to make fringe that looks like grass. Tape it inside your crown so the fringe shows.



Now, make your flowers! Take tissues or coffee filters and bunch them into flower shapes. Tape your flowers at the stem.



Use watercolor paint or food color and dab the color on your flower with the paintbrush.



Tape your flowers on your crown and it is ready for you to wear! Have fun!
